Greetings:

I am writing the Board of Directors of the Economic Development Authority of Grayson County, Virginia (EDA) regarding the release of an Irrevocable Letter of Credit (IRLOC) written for the benefit of the EDA by Grayson National Bank (now known as Skyline National Bank) for applicant McAllister Mills, Inc., of 173 Rainbow Circle.

The IRLOC, numbered 7287185, was issued in the amount of \$55,000 USD (fifty-five thousand and 00/100 United States Dollars) with an issue date of April 8, 2015. Loan-to-date, there have been no draws on the subject IRLOC.

The letter was originally for benefit of the Economic Development Authority of Grayson County, Virginia in an economic package with the Tobacco Region Opportunity Fund (TROF) through the Tobacco Indemnification and Community Revitalization Commission.

It is our understanding that all factors requiring the existence of this IRLOC have been satisfied during the month of June 2024 by McAllister Mills, Inc.

With this understanding, we hereby formally request the release of this IRLOC through the return of the original letter and an issued letter from the EDA confirming release.
