APPROVAL OF MINUTES

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Boyer covered McAllister Mills pay off noting the repayment agreement between McAllister Mills and EDA signed on 6/13/22 for \$35,893.36 – McAllister paid the agreement off after it was found to be in arrears – once amount was paid off the amount due of \$35,893.36, the amount was sent in two separate payments of \$11,893.36 and \$24,000 to the Tobacco Commission. ➢ Gold Hill Cider Extension - Mitchell Britt - Mrs. Young noted that Mr. Britt didn't get the AFID Grant and is requesting an extension on the EDA money. Mr. Britt updated the EDA and noted a certificate of occupancy should be received in 1 − 1.5 months; formally asking for an extension; has been in touch with SERCAP; may consider asking EDA for a low interest loan; septic is in and will drill for the well soon; need approximately \$120,000 to close the gap. Mr. Butler commended Mr. Britt on the process he has followed. Mr. Rascoe made the motion to extend the agreement until December 31, 2024; duly seconded by Mr. Cannaday. Motion carried 4-0.
