IN RE: OPENING BUSINESS

IN RE: REGISTERED SPEAKER(S) AND PUBLIC COMMENT(S)

- Carolyn Trenkamp of Point Lookout Lane/Independence – addressed the Board and noted she’s here on behalf of members of the Point Lookout Mountain Homeowners Association regarding a problem with no longer having the convenience center open – concerned about safety/litter on Peach Bottom Rd – currently have 10 residents – no place to put metal – asking Board to reconsider reopening the convenience center. Mr. Boyer spoke and noted that something will need to be figured out and for Mrs. Trenkamp to give him a call.

IN RE: OLD BUSINESS

- Comprehensive Plan Amendments (repeal & replace the adopted 2018 Comprehensive Plan in its entirety. Content, maps, goals, objectives, and strategies for all chapters have been revised and/or replaced entirely to address updated data & priorities identified through research & with the Code of Virginia. Updates to the Comprehensive Plan also include adding the Grayson County Parks & Recreation Master Plan & a Comprehensive Plan Implementation Matrix. Mrs. Jada Black, Director of Planning & Community Development, addressed the Board asking for approval & adoption of the Comprehensive Plan. Discussion took place regarding page 3-5 under 3-3/3-4 regarding removing pre-1976 manufactured homes/environmental health – Mrs. Black noted that particular strategy has been in the Comp Plan a long time and that’s very hard to accomplish – the Building Official is very adamant about not forcing anyone out of their home – regarding environmental health, building/planning works with VDH along with Rooftop who helps with the IPR program; statistical information seemed dated; Mrs. Black noted this is a working document so it can be revised as needed and also noted that a complete rewrite is needed in the future which will include new surveys/community & public meetings, etc.

- Supervisor Anderson noted that he's received several calls regarding the trash bins at Public Works – a lot of misinformation circulating regarding the trash bins – reiterated that the County no longer has a contract with the Town of Independence which created a huge deficit in the revenue for the County – the Town has contracted with a different vendor and if the County opens it back up, people in town that are not signed up with the new vendor will be using the County Convenience Center and the County paying for it – also suggested again to consider placing a dumpster in each district one Saturday/month and divvy the Saturdays up amongst the Public Works employees – closed the convenience center because it's for the best interest of the taxpayers - recycling bins are still open – Mr. Boyer spoke regarding the issues we are having with the recycling bins at Baywood – people are dumping their trash in the recycling bins and long the bins – we will be placing cameras there and will go through the trash if necessary to find out who is doing this – will get the Sheriff involved if necessary – we actually make money on our recycling because the public works employees sort it where as a vendor like GFL is losing money because they don't sort their recycles.
